# Music Notes

If our anthem Gentle Mary Laid Her Child sounds familiar to you it might be because of the music and the words. The music tune is listed as Piae Cantiones but the full title is Piae Cantiones ecclesiasticae et scholiasticae veterum episcoporum which roughly translates to "pious ecclesiastic and school songs of the ancient bishops." This was a collection of 74 songs compiled in 1582 in the town of Turku; then the capital of Finland. The particular song tune from the collection used here is *Tempus adest floridum* which translates to "Eastertime has come"; although we know it as "Good King Wenceslas." Music for Easter used for a secular carol (the story of Wenceslas), and then for a sacred Christmas hymn – the adaptability of music has almost no limits. As for the words, in addition to your Bulletin, you will find them in the hymnal at #156. The hymn/anthem starts by describing the birth of a seemingly unremarkable child. But in verse two, angels, shepherds, heaven's star, wise men, and glory surround the child making clear that this is the Son of God. Verse three reminds us that this is a human child but the fulfillment of prophecy and he is to be praised in all the earth.

The Carol of the Star has words and music by Donald Moore (1946-). The text places the "star" at the center of the birth story; first leading the wise men, then the angels, before shining "o'er all the earth." The anthem uses a changing interplay between the women's and men's voices to add drama to the telling of the story. The addition of the phrase, "Venite adoremus Domium" (come, let us worship the Lord) adds a level of majesty to the carol.
